

FCC Tower

Regina, Saskatchewan



FCC Tower is a 187,000 square foot building that provides office, retail and below-grade parking. The building's approved massing option and core configuration produced the City of Regina's most efficient gross to useable ratio, while retaining Class 'A' services. With this high level of efficiency, the building was able to win two separate office tender calls and was 100% leased at completion.

In 2007, FCC Tower received Go Green accreditation from the Building Owners and Managers Association of Canada. The achievement acknowledges that environmental best practices have been implemented in the management of this property.

The property was developed through a Co-ownership with City Centre Equities and Saskatchewan Government Insurance (SGI). Currently, Farm Credit Canada and the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce operate out of FCC Tower.

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
