PROJECT OVERVIEW

Nestled on the doorstep of the scenic Wascana Park and just minutes away from downtown Regina, this project presents an ideal location for a neighbourhood grocery and pharmacy. With the potential to cater to the adjacent condominium community, the steady flow of commuter traffic to and from downtown, along with the diverse population of staff, students, and visitors of the nearby University of Regina and First Nations University of Canada, this opportunity is not one to be missed.

Welcome to The Vue at Lakeshore.

Situated within an area boasting a daytime population of 74,100 within a 3 km radius, The Vue at Lakeshore has been designed as a dense mixed-use development. Mid-rise luxury condominiums are planned for the south side of the development, adjacent to 23rd Avenue.

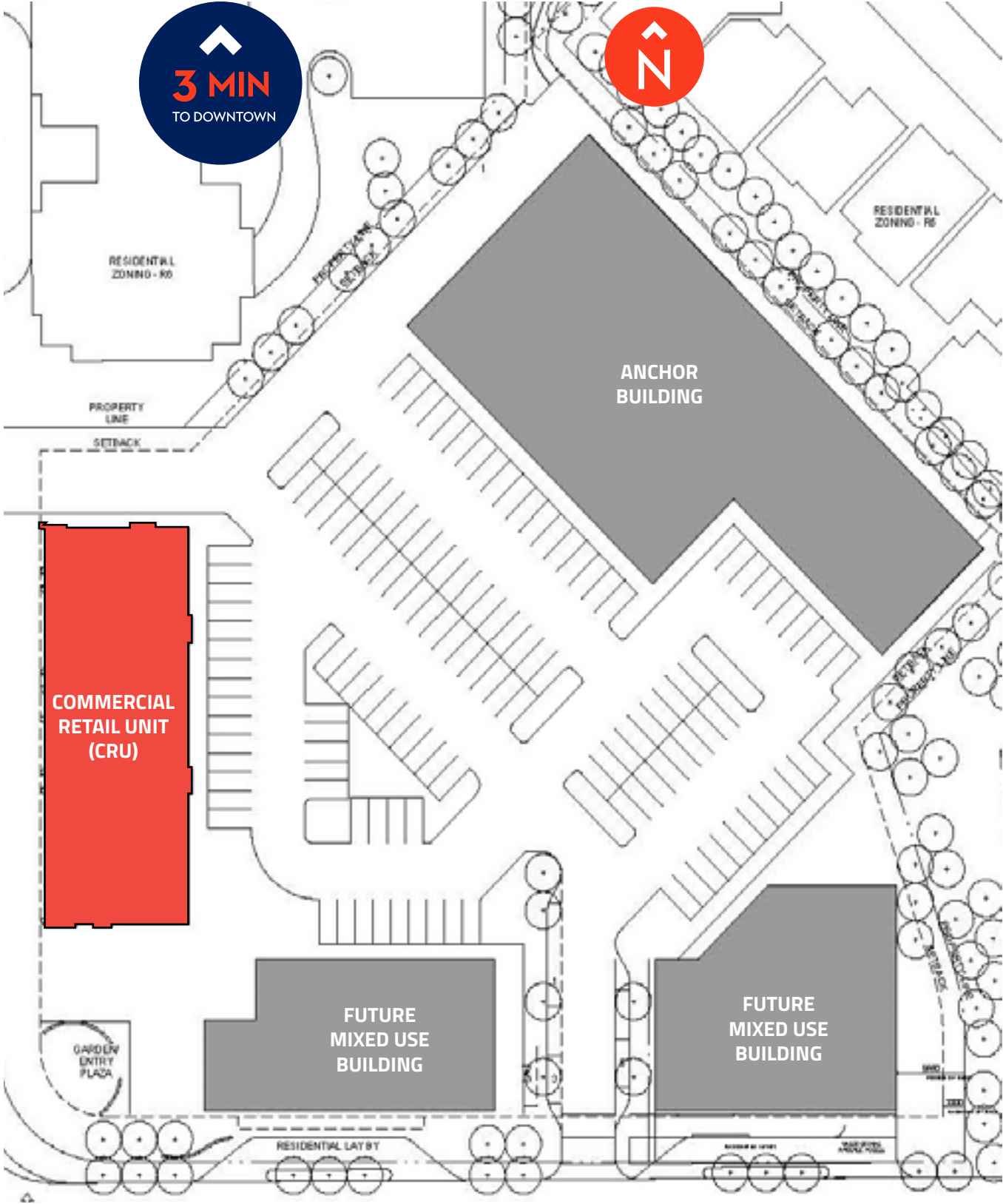

HILLSDALE STREET (12,600 VPD)

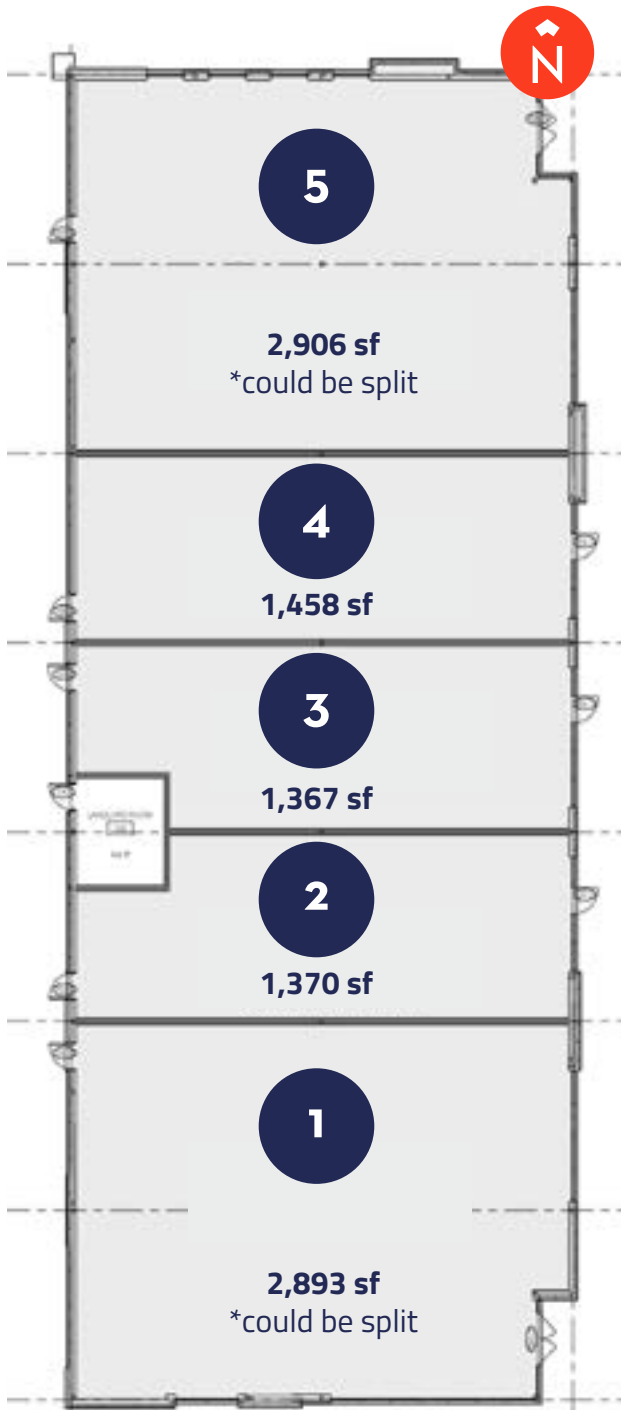

CONEXUS ART CENTRE – Regina’s world-class performing arts centre and theatre complex, which features a broad range of conventions, theatre productions, concerts, and graduations.

MACKENZIE ART GALLERY – is Saskatchewan’s oldest public art gallery with a permanent collection of nearly 5,000 works spanning 5,000 years.

WASCANA CENTRE – 150-hectare lake in the heart of Regina, Wascana Centre is home to 2,300 acres of urban land that provides a place to work, learn and play. It features 8.7km of paved pathway, and 5.6km of natural paths, recreation and play areas, as well as a Habitat Conservation Area.

UNIVERSITY OF REGINA – the U of R has 10 faculties, 25 departments, 10 institutional level research centres and 3 federated colleges and averages over 16,000 full time and part time students annually.

FIRST NATIONS UNIVERSITY OF CANADA - one of the oldest First Nations post-secondary institutions in the country.
